
(0) Fruit description

- Shape: circular, regular, with a little dip at the stem end
- **Skin**: shiny and intense red, very attractive. The fruit skin is moderatly thick and very clean, with few or no lenticels.
- **Core**: medium sized, clingstone
- Firmness: very good
- Flesh: smooth and juicy
- Organoleptic qualities: very good, smooth and aromatic

Production

In good production conditions, the yield can reach 30 T/Ha.

The dominant fruit size is A/AA, with an average weight of 150-160 g.

• Bud break : early

• **Period**: early

Bloom set: strong

Fruit setting: strong

Thinning: important

හි Tree

Habit : erect

Vigor: strong

Wood qualities : good

 Shape pruning: topping must be done during the 1st and 2nd years to open the scaffold branches. Head back the scaffold if necessary.

 Regular pruning: on young flowering shoots and vigorous 2 year old wood.

 Summer pruning: Indispensable to ventilate the inner part of the tree. Post harvest pruning will improve the quality of the bearing wood for the following year.
