Truit description


- Shape: circular, slightly assymmetric, with a space at the stem end
- **Skin**: dark red intense. Skin is moderatly thick with a little fuzz.
- Core: medium sized, semi clingstone
- Firmness: good
- Flesh: smooth and juicy
- Organoleptic qualities: good, well balanced with aromatic flavours.



Production

In good production conditions, the yield can reach 40T/Ha.

The dominant fruit size is A/AA, with an average weight of 180 -190 g.

Fruit setting: strong


Thinning: medium



• Habit : semi erect

Wood qualities : good



- Regular pruning: on vigorous flowering shoots and 2 year old wood
- Summer pruning: indispensable to favor the fruit coloration of the and to clean the inner part of the trees. Post harvest pruning is necessary to select good quality wood for the following year.
