

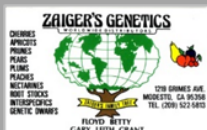

🕒 Description du fruit

The fruit has a round, very attractive shape, with a small dip at its top. The fruit skin colour varies from garnet red to pink, and is characterised by a low pubescence.

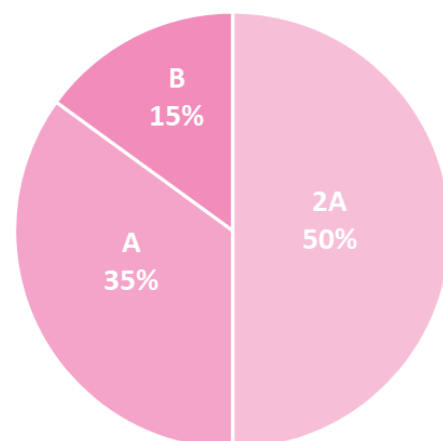
The semi-freestone is small to medium sized. Firmness of the fruit is good.

The flesh is creamy white, and characterised by a light red lining under the skin, which is not found around the stone. The flavor is good, the acidity level is mild. The general eating quality is good, the aromatic intensity very satisfying. The texture is smooth and juicy.

🌱 Production

In good production conditions, the yield can reach **40T/Ha**

The dominant fruit size is **AA**, with an average weight of **180-190g**.

🗨️ Fruit characteristics

- ◆ Split cores susceptibility : weak
- ◆ Rot susceptibility : weak
- ◆ Sensitivity to handling : low to medium

🌸 Blooming

- ◆ **Bud break** : semi early
- ◆ **Period** : semi early, Patty® + 4 days
- ◆ **Bloom set** : medium to high
- ◆ **Fruit setting** : low to medium
- ◆ **Thinning** : weak

🌳 Tree

- ◆ **Habit** : semi-erect to erect
- ◆ **Vigor** : medium to strong
- ◆ **Wood qualities** : good



- ◆ **Shape pruning** : an open structure must be encouraged. For that, summer topping must be done during the 1st and the 2nd years. Subsequently, the trees will be trained by pruning rather than bending.
- ◆ **Regular pruning** : 2 year old wood and the strongest flowering shoots are preserved, even if they are in an acrotone position on the branches.
- ◆ **Summer pruning** : Essential to clean the inner part of the trees. Pruning can be done after the harvest to favor new buds on old branches.

- ◆ **Productivity** : strong
- ◆ **Fruit set** : rapid
