Blooming

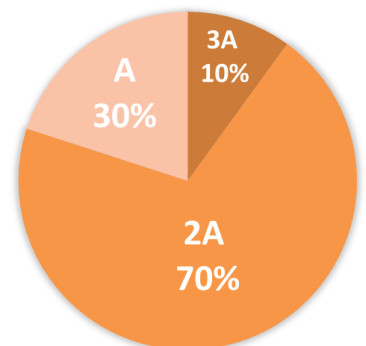
- ◆ **Period** : similar to Farbaly (cov)

- ◆ **Productivity** : good
- ◆ **Fruit set** : rapid
