High production potential

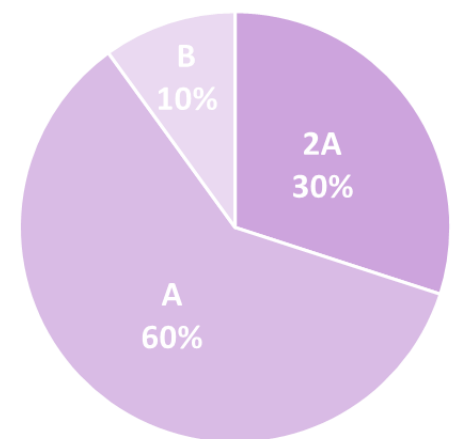
🕒 Fruit description

- ◆ **Shape** : slightly oblate
- ◆ **Skin** : shiny dark red. The fruit skin is moderately thick with almost no lenticels.
- ◆ **Core** : medium sized, clingstone
- ◆ **Firmness** : very good
- ◆ **Flesh** : crunchy and juicy
- ◆ **Organoleptic qualities** : very good, with smooth taste and aromatic flavours

🌿 Production

In good production conditions, the yield can reach **40-45 T/Ha**.

The dominant fruit size is **A/AA**, with an average weight of **180 -190 g**.

- ◆ **Rot susceptibility** : weak
- ◆ **Sensitivity to handling** : weak

- ◆ **Bud break** : mid season
- ◆ **Period** : mid season
- ◆ **Bloom set** : high
- ◆ **Fruit setting** : strong
- ◆ **Thinning** : medium

🌳 Tree

- ◆ **Habit** : semi erect
- ◆ **Vigor** : strong
- ◆ **Wood qualities** : good
- ◆ **Shape pruning** : topping must be done during the 1st and 2nd years to train the scaffold branches.
- ◆ **Regular pruning** : on all type of wood
- ◆ **Summer pruning** : indispensable for a nice coloration of the fruits and to favor the ventilation of the inner part of the trees. Post harvest pruning is really valuable.
- ◆ **Productivity** : strong
- ◆ **Fruit set:** rapid
