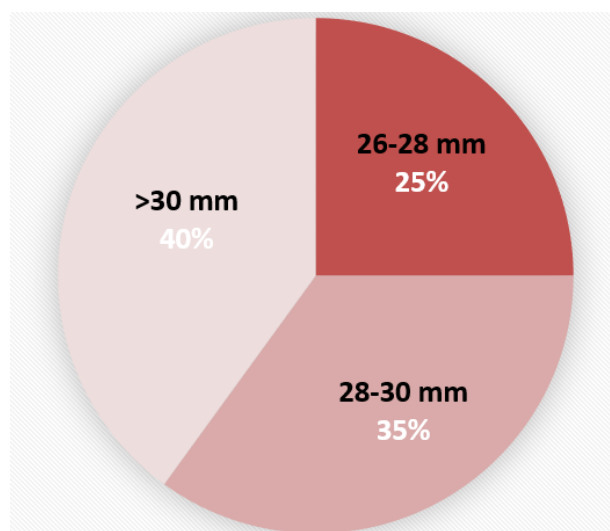

Fruit description

- ◆ **Shape** : circular
- ◆ **Color** : deep dark red colour (CTIFL code 4/5)
- ◆ **Dominant fruit size** : 30/32
- ◆ **Stem** : thick with medium length
- ◆ **Texture** : creamy and juicy
- ◆ **Organoleptic qualities** : sweet, low level of acidity, strong aromatic components
- ◆ **Firmness (Durofel 25)** : 70/80
- ◆ **Brix** : 15%
- ◆ **Acidity (meq/100ml)** : 14

- ◆ **Flowering time** : early—similar to Sweetheart®
- ◆ **Pollination** : Samba® - Sweetheart® - Folfer (cov) - Royal Hermione®
- ◆ **Alleles** : S1 S3

Tree

- ◆ **Habit** : moderately open
- ◆ **Vigor** : moderate
- ◆ **Fruit bearing** : on shoots
- ◆ **Productivity** : high
- ◆ **Fruit set** : rapid
- ◆ **Fruit distribution on branches** : even
- ◆ **Branching angle**: 45/60°

Fruit characteristics

- ◆ **Cracking tolerance** : medium
- ◆ **Monilia susceptibility** : weak to medium
- ◆ **Handling susceptibility** : medium
- ◆ **Double fruit occurrence** : low
- ◆ **Good aptitude** to stemless harvest
