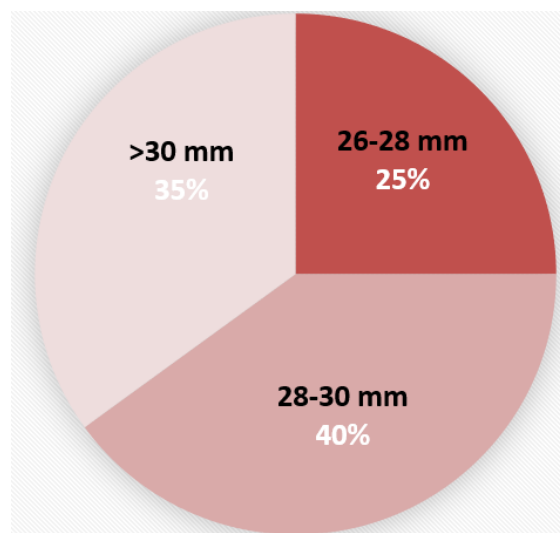
Fruit description

- ◆ Shape : kidney shaped
- ◆ Color : carmine colour (CTIFL code 4/5)
- ◆ Dominant fruit size : 28/30
- ◆ Stem : thick with medium length
- ◆ Texture : creamy and juicy
- ◆ Organoleptic qualities : a sweet cherry, with a mild taste and marked aromatic components
- ◆ Firmness (Durofel 25) : 70/80
- ◆ Brix : 17/19%
- ◆ Acidity (meq/100ml) : 11/12

Blooming

- ◆ Flowering time : Early — Sweetheart® time
- ◆ Self-fertile variety
- ◆ Alleles : S1 S4'

Tree

- ◆ **Habit:** erected
- ◆ **Vigor :** strong
- ◆ **Fruit bearing :** strong and dense, on shoots
- ◆ **Productivity :** very high
- ◆ **Fruit set :** very rapid
- ◆ **Fruit spreading on branches:** good
- ◆ **Branching angle:** 60/70°



Fruit characteristics

- ◆ **Cracking tolerance :** medium
- ◆ **Monilia susceptibility :** medium
- ◆ **Handling susceptibility :** very weak
- ◆ **Double fruit occurrence :** very low
- ◆ **Good aptitude** to stemless harvest
