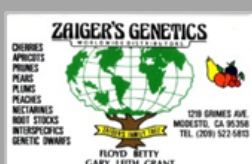

Interesting variety for its early maturity

High caliber potential and good firmness.

The fruit is very attractive

Fruit description

A rounded fruit, with a shiny dark red color (color code CTIFL 5). The fruit is sweet, with a mild flavour, and strong aromatic components. The flesh texture is creamy and juicy. The fruit is very firm. The potential for a 28 to 30mm fruit size is high, and observed all over the tree even if the fruit load is significant. The stem is thick, of medium length, rarely producing double fruits.

Fruit characteristics

- ◆ **Firmness** : very good (Durofel 25 : 65-75)
- ◆ **Brix** : 14 % Brix
- ◆ **Tolerance au cracking** : medium
- ◆ **Sensitivity to au monilia** : low to medium
- ◆ **Sensitivity to handling** : low
- ◆ **Good aptitude** to harvest without stem

Blooming

- ◆ **Period** : Early—7 days prior to Burlat
- ◆ **Pollination** : Royal Bailey (cov) , Samba®, Rosie (cov)
- ◆ **Alleles** : S3 S9

Tree

- ◆ **Shape** : semi – spreading
- ◆ **Vigor** : medium
- ◆ **Fruit bearing** : on shoots' extremity
- ◆ **Productivity** : medium
- ◆ **Fruit set** : rapid
- ◆ **Fruit's distribution along the branches** : good
