
(f) Fruit description

- Shape: circular, slightly flattened at the stem end
- **Skin**: shiny dark red on the full fruit skin. Skin is moderatly thick, with few fuzz.
- **Core**: medium sized, semi clingstone
- Firmness: very good
- Flesh: crunchy and juicy
- Organoleptic qualities: very good, with smooth and aromatic flavours

Production

In good production conditions, the yield can reach 30-35T/Ha.

The dominant fruit size is A, with an average weight of 160 -170g.

Bud break: mid season

Period : late

Bloom set : medium to strong

Fruit setting: strong

 Thinning: medium to strong

• **Habit**: semi erect

Vigor : strong

• Wood qualities: good

 Shape pruning: topping must be done during the 1st and the 2nd years. If needed, the scaffold branches will be opened by bending.

Regular pruning: on vigorous shoots or the ones inserted on 2
year old wood. Permanent regrowth must be privileged, because
the branches can age rapidly.

• **Summer pruning :** Indispensable to maintain a good wood quality for the following year. Post harvest pruning is recommanded.
