
(0) Fruit description

- Shape: circular, regular, slightly flattened at the stem end
- Skin: shiny dark red on 70 to 80% of the fruit skin with an oranged yellow background Skin is thick and has a little fuzz.
- **Core**: medium sized, semi clingstone
- Firmness: very good
- Flesh: smoothy and juicy
- Organoleptic qualities: good, smooth and aromatic

Production

In good production conditions, the yield can reach 45T/Ha.

The dominant fruit size is AA/A, with an average weight of 180 -190 g.

Bud break : mid season

• Period : mid season

Bloom set : strong

Fruit setting: strong

Thinning: low to medium

• **Habit**: semi erect

Vigor: strong

Wood quality : good

- Shape pruning: topping must be done during the 1st and 2nd years. Subsequently the scaffold branches must be opened by bending. Sub scaffold branches must be established by bending rather than pruning.
- Regular pruning: on flowering shoots and vigorous 2 year old wood. Be careful to establish renewal shoots starting from vigorous branches and sustain them until they grew enough.
- Summer pruning: indispensable for a nice coloration of the fruits and to ventilate the inner part of the trees. Post harvest pruning is recommanded.

Productivity: very high

• Fruit set: rapid
